Any participant who is absent for more than nine hours of class time, for whatever reason, or does not participate in the class project and turn in signed agenda from a civic meeting, shall be dropped from the program. Any class time missed, including arriving late or leaving early, counts towards the nine hours. **The Challenge Course is a required activity and cannot be missed.** Tuition is non-refundable.

COMMITMENT PLEDGE

- 1) I wish to participate in Leadership HEB, a program of The HEB Chamber of Commerce.
- 2) I have my company's/organization's support for my participation.
- 3) I will actively participate in the class project which requires hours outside of the class time.
- 4) I understand I will be dropped from the program and not graduate if I miss more than 9 hours of class time, do not participate in the class project or attend a civic meeting.
- 5) I will remit my check for \$450 to the HEB Chamber for tuition two weeks prior to orientation.

Applications are due by **August 29, 2014**. There will be an orientation meeting on September 25 from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and a full-day mandatory challenge course session on Friday, October 10. Regular sessions meet from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the following Thursday dates: October 23, November 6, December 4, January 15, January 29, February 19, March 5 and April 2. Should one of the above dates be cancelled due to weather, the make up date will be April 16. The all-day trip to the State Capitol will be Thursday, March 19.
